FY 2021 AHS Closeout Highlights and Issues

- AHS leveraged Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF) and other COVID-19 federal funding
 - DOC CRF for substantially dedicated salaries per Commissioner <u>Greshin's memo</u> to JFC on June 22 may be used for Medicaid pressures in FY22
 - VDH Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC)
 - DCF FEMA General Assistance Emergency Housing
- FEMA shifted from 75/25 to 100% Federal Financial Participation (FFP)
 - AHS has anticipated receipts of \$38.1M, DCF \$10.3M
 - FEMA reimbursement-based program
- Underspend in the DAIL Choices for Care program, DCF Child Development
- DOC Structural funding shortfall in the Vermont Offender Work Program (VOWP)



FY21 Global Commitment General Fund Reversion per C.102 of Act 74 of 2021

- \$42,516,329 GF was reverted on June 10, 2021
 - Includes impact of enhanced FMAP in AHS Global Commitment (\$40,099,895), DVHA (\$1,559,959) and DCF for IV-E (\$856,475)
 - AHS's carryforward request includes \$856K to transfer from DCF to AHS GC for IV-E FMAP impact

FY22 Global Commitment General Fund Reversion per D.104 of Act 74 of 2021

- \$66,000,000 GF shall be reverted in FY22
 - Public Health Emergency has been extended for an additional 90 days to mid-October
 - As such, enhanced FMAP of 6.2% will be earned through December 31, 2021 roughly \$44M though this is an estimate
 - Federal HHS will need to determine whether to extend PHE for an additional 90 days in mid-October and therefore, leverage 6.2% FMAP through March 31, 2022
 - Some direction from CMS State Medicaid Director Letter Footnote
