Agenda Item B. – Motion (1): VEGI Program –Proposed Enhanced Incentive Cap Increase

Senator Baruth moved to authorize, in accordance with 32 V.S.A. § 3441(b), the Vermont Economic Progress Council to make materials submitted by businesses requesting Vermont Economic Growth Incentives available to the Joint Fiscal Office and its agent for the purposes of examining the applications of 2022 Labor Market Area Enhancement awardees and the processes for awarding 2022 and prior year enhancements.

Agenda Item B. – Motion (2): VEGI Program –Proposed Enhanced Incentive Cap Increase

Representative Ancel moved to postpone action on increasing the Vermont Employment Growth Incentive Labor Market Area Enhancement cap to the November meeting of the Joint Fiscal Committee.

Senator Baruth moved to approve the Department for Children and Families plan to spend the remaining American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Child Care Development Fund Discretionary funds for Quality Coaches (\$2.5M) and Administrative Costs (\$639,732). The funds must be obligated by September 30, 2022.
