Please find attached report required pursuant to 3 VSA Sec 2281(4).

The FY 2026 Pay Act appropriations were made in Act 113 of 2024 as follows:

## **Executive Branch**

\$24,644,442	General Fund	Sec. $G.109(a)(2)(A)$
\$3,000,000	Transportation Fund	Sec.G.109(a)(2)(B)

Judicial Branch

\$2,388,783 General Fund Sec.G.109(b)(3)

Legislative Branch

\$758,613 General Fund Sec.G.109(c)(2)

The attached report identifies projected allocations by department of the FY2026 Pay Act appropriations listed above, and the report's calculation methodology is described below.

Please note, final Executive Pay Act allocations occur near the end of the fiscal year, are based on each department's actual need at that time, and may differ from the estimated allocations listed in the attached report.

## **Pay Act Calculation Methodology**

The methodology used in developing Pay Act potential need is as follows:

- The General and Transportation Fund share of the required Pay Act are derived from the FY 2026 As Passed budget which reflects an estimated annualized June 30, 2025 payroll base.
- Executive Branch Pay Act need for all departments except Corrections is estimated based on assuming a 3.50% cost of living increase and step increases at an aggregate rate of 1.9%. These increases are applied to salaries and to salary-driven benefit costs (FICA, retirement, life insurance, and long-term disability) for all individual employee positions that are budgeted in FY 2026.

- Legislative Pay Act distribution is estimated by allocating the total Legislative Pay Act amount appropriated in FY26 according to the following percentages: 43% to Legislature, 25.5% to Legislative Counsel, 15.9% to Joint Fiscal Office, 7.9% to Legislative Information Technology, and 7.6% to Sergeant at Arms.
- Judicial Pay Act need is estimated by allocating 100% of the FY26 Judicial Pay Act appropriation to the Judiciary appropriation.
- The costs of various non-salary contract items and other bargained provisions are stipulated in certain articles of the State-VSEA Bargaining Agreement.
