Introduction: This table shows the average daily membership (ADM) of students that are economically disadvantaged by district and sorted alphabetically by county. These data are from the Vermont Agency of Education for the year FY22 and use the current law definition. The current law includes students aged 6-17 who reside with families receiving nutrition benefits (SNAP) or students not receiving nutrition benefits but for whom English is not the primary language. The Secretary of Education has discretion to use a measure that produces reasonably representative long-term trends. In total, there are 15,243 students that are economically-disadvantaged.
