H.740 – An act relating to the greenhouse gas inventory and registry

As recommended by the House Committee on Energy and Digital Infrastructure, Draft 2.3¹

Bill Summary

This bill proposes to give the Agency of Natural Resources (ANR) additional authority to collect data for the greenhouse gas inventory and registry.

Fiscal Impact

This bill would give authority to the Secretary of Natural Resources to adopt rules that create a comprehensive greenhouse gas emission reporting program. In addition to other funds appropriated to ANR in fiscal year 2027, this bill would appropriate \$500,000 in base funding. It would also create two new permanent classified positions at ANR. The cost of these positions would be included in the \$500,000 base funding appropriation.

Background and Details

Section 3

In order to support the drafting of the greenhouse gas emission reporting program, development of a greenhouse gas source database, and the staff required to implement emission source data collection, this bill appropriates \$500,000 in additional base funding to ANR in fiscal year 2027.

This bill would also create two new permanent classified positions in ANR. The estimated total cost for these positions in fiscal year 2027 is \$185,000.
