S.41 An act relating to regulating entities that administer tax-advantaged accounts for health-related expenses

As Passed by the General Assembly (Act No.54)

The bill directs the Department of Financial Regulations (DFR) to adopt rules regulating taxadvantaged accounts for health services such as flexible spending accounts (FSAs), health reimbursement arrangements (HRAs), and health savings accounts (HSAs). These entities will pay a fee of \$600.00 (on or before December 31) every three years. It is estimated that 5 to 6 entities would be covered by this regulation, resulting in the collection of approximately \$3,000 to \$3,600 in the first calendar year.
