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FISCAL NOTE

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H.430 – An act relating to expanding eligibility for Dr. Dynasaur to all income-eligible children and pregnant individuals regardless of immigration status

Further recommendation of amendment by the House Committee on Appropriations

The bill as amended proposes to expand eligibility for Dr. Dynasaur to all income-eligible children and pregnant individuals, regardless of immigration status.

Sec. 2 would appropriate \$1,400,000.00 in one-time state funds to the Agency of Human Services (AHS) in FY 2022 to be used for:

- Grants and/or reimbursements to health care providers for delivering health services to children and pregnant individuals who are undocumented immigrants;
- Grants to Vermont organizations that work with members of Vermont's undocumented immigrant community or with members of the health care provider community to provide outreach and information; and
- Implementing the technological and operational processes necessary for the Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) to administer the Dr. Dynasaur expansion.

Fiscal Impact: FY 2022 appropriation to AHS = \$1,400,000.00 (one-time state dollars)

Sec. 3 would require AHS to provide information on the estimated FY 2023 costs of expanding Dr. Dynasaur eligibility to children and pregnant individuals who are undocumented immigrants as part of the Agency's FY 2023 budget presentation to specific legislative committees of jurisdiction.

Sec. 4 would make coverage available to eligible children and pregnant individuals who are undocumented immigrants beginning on July 1, 2022, subject to fiscal year 2023 appropriations for this purpose.

Fiscal Impact: the FY 2023 impact will be subject to the FY 2023 appropriation for this purpose.
