### **S.219 – An act relating to an energy navigator program report**

**As recommended by the Senate Committee on Appropriations<sup>1,i</sup>**

#### **Bill Summary**

**T**his bill would direct the Department of Public Service (PSD) to contract with a third-party consultant to design a community-based home energy navigator and coaching program for residential consumers. This program would provide in-person and remote energy coaching services to residential consumers on topics such as weatherization, home energy efficiency, clean energy investments, and project financing. The bill would direct PSD to develop this program in consultation with the Climate Action Center of Addison County and similar navigator programs statewide.

On or before March 1, 2027, PSD would submit a report on program design to the House Committee on Energy and Digital Infrastructure and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy. This report would include descriptions of potential program structures, estimated energy and emissions savings, estimated program costs, and funding sources.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

As recommended by the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy, Section 2 would appropriate \$25,000 in fiscal year 2027 from the General Fund to the PSD to hire a third-party consultant for report preparation and \$10,000 to the Climate Economy Action Center of Addison County to collaborate with PSD on energy navigator program design. The Senate Committee on Appropriations' recommendation removes the appropriations from the bill and inserts language to make PSD's duty to hire a consultant, and to grant funding to the Climate Economy Action Center of Addison County, contingent upon an appropriation in fiscal year 2027 for these purposes.
