





- High participation rate in Vermont





Blueprint for Health receives data from VITL to support DocSite/analysis



- Secure messaging solution for care summaries

VITLAccess

- Provider portal: window into clinical repository
- Began deployment July 18 --> Begin onboarding in September
- Culmination of 9 years supporting EHR adoption building interfaces and infrastructure
- Processing 4.1 million clinical messages per month

VITLNotify


- Component of the Population Based Collaborative HIE Project

- All licensed providers in VT will be offered this service




NY Gateway
