COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

This memo is to inform the Agency of Administration that the Vermont Agency of Agriculture. Food & Markets (VAAFM) will be awarded \$500,000 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) as part of the Local Food Purchase Assistance (LFPA) Cooperative Agreement Program.

Enclosed is USDA's notice that the application has been accepted and that the grant agreement is currently being processed in the ezFedGrants system. This cooperative agreement will be covered by the most recent AMS Grants Division General Terms and Conditions. The grant has a two-year project period beginning August 1, 2022.

This funding allows VAAFM to advance efforts to improve local food access, reduce food insecurity, and support socially disadvantaged farmers. VAAFM will fund the projects of six Vermont nonprofits, all of which will purchase food from local farms and distribute that food to individuals experiencing food insecurity. VAAFM will also funds to execute competitive subawards to approximately five to seven grantees, both farms and nonprofits, that demonstrate the ability to produce or procure fresh food and distribute that food to communities in need.

The grant includes funding for Abenaki Helping Abenaki, Capstone Community Action, The Center for an Agricultural Economy, The Intervale Center, Vermont Foodbank and the Vermont Land Trust to begin work on six projects to purchase food from local and socially disadvantaged farmers and begin distributing that food to underserved communities and food insecure





Vermonters during this growing season. Because of Vermont's short growing season, we would greatly appreciate an expedited review of this request so that these organizations can begin this important work to purchase and provide food this season.

The following outlines the scope of work for the grant.

- VAAFM staff will fund six pre-identified projects across the state and will offer oversight and support for these projects.
- VAAFM will develop a competitive grant program and application, launch a request for applications in November 2022, and review applications and offer funds by March 2023.
- VAAFM staff will oversee grant deliverables during the entire period of the competitive grant while offering support for the projects chosen.

Funding will be used primarily for = purchases of local food. VAAFM has budgeted \$11,260 of the award to fund salary and benefits of a current Agriculture Development Supervisor position who will oversee the award and claiming \$3,738 in indirect costs.
