Subject: Grant Request #2732, #2733, #2734, #2735, #2736

Enclosed please find five (5) items that the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the administration. Three (3) limited-service positions are associated with these requests.

JFO #2732 – Donation of 20 acres (estimated value: \$54,000) from William Jackson to the Vermont Department of Fish & Wildlife. The land, located in the town of Starksboro, will become part of the Lewis Creek Wildlife Management Area and will protect public access for hunting, fishing, and wildlife viewing. \$7,500 of federal Pittman-Robertson funding will be used to cover legal costs associated with this acquisition. Expedited review has been requested. Joint Fiscal Committee members will be contacted by December 29th with a request to waive the balance of the review period and accept this donation. JFO #2733 – \$56,000 donation from the Vermont National Guard Charitable Foundation to the Vermont Military Department. These funds will support the maintenance and upkeep of the Vermont National Guard Fallen Heroes Memorial at Camp Johnson in Colchester over a five-year period and will support the purchase of a new Bobcat mower.

JFO #2734 – \$68,000 grant from The Nature Conservancy to the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources, Dept. of Forests, Parks and Recreation. These funds will be used to improve invasive plant management in Vermont through site prioritization and the development of evaluation techniques. This grant will act as a match for existing federal monies from the U.S. Forest Service. **One** (1) **limited-service position**, a Forester I, is associated with this request. JFO #2735 – \$885,072 grant from the U.S. Administration for Children and Families to the Vermont Agency of Human Services, Department for Children and Family. 34% of the funds are through a Behavioral Intervention in Child Support Services (BICS) grant and the remainder from Federal Financial Participation (FFP) matching funds. These funds will be used over three years to test and evaluate proposed behavioral interventions aimed at positively impacting child support collections for Vermont families. The total anticipated grant and match funding will amount to \$1,147,057 and be received over a five-year period.

JFO #2736 – \$663,614 grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to the Vermont Department of Health. These funds will be used over a three-year period to work with partners around the State to incorporate factors associated with quality-of-life into the State's analysis of health resources and expenditures. **Two (2)** limited-service positions, a Grants Program Manager and a Senior Health Policy Analyst, are associated with this request.

8. Purpose of Grant:

The objective is to improve integration and institutionalization of invasive plant management in Vermont by establishing critical capacity for program management and leadership, developing early detection and rapid response plans, developing labor capacity to manage invasives, and developing long term capacity for related support tools such as IMAP and VTInvasives. The position will help prioritize sites for management of invasive plant species and develop evaluation techniques with the goal of helping decision makers target limited funds and make the best use of labor, particularly volunteer time. Funding for this position comes from multiple sources, new funding from The Nature Conservancy and existing funding through a USDA USFS grant and interdepartmental funding provided by DEC.

9. Impact on existing program if grant is not Accepted:

If the grant is not accepted the State would lose capacity to coordinate a statewide program for providing education and outreach, management guidance and response to invasive plant issues statewide. The funding provided to the State from The Nature Conservancy is intended to replace work that The Nature Conservancy currently conducts and enhance the States' capacity for invasive plant management..


