Enclosed please find three (3) items that the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the administration.

JFO #2848 – \$248,989 grant from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets. The funds will be used to help fund education and outreach to Vermont meat producers with a focus on teaching veterinary medication and residue avoidance best practices. These actions will be aimed at reducing Vermont's high level of violative drug residues found in the tissues of livestock.

JFO #2849 – \$9,970 grant from the National Network of Public Health Institute to the Vermont Dept. of Health. The grant will be used to expand the Department's ability to conduct Health Impact Assessments (HIA) in order to further implement the State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP). The funds will cover the salaries, benefits, travel and meeting costs for district office employees who attend HIA training.

JFO #2850 – \$339,861 grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to the Vermont Dept. of Libraries. The grant will be used to fund the Vermont Early Literacy Initiative – Science, Technology, Economics, Mathematics (VELI-STEM). Funds will be used over three years in 26 libraries across the State to introduce STEM learning to Vermont children and families and to develop a STEM learning model to be used in communities nationwide. A letter from the Secretary of Administration to the Joint Fiscal Committee is attached to the grant materials informing the committee that funds from this grant were expended prior to JFC approval, and contains an explanation of what occurred.

Please find attached an AA-1 for your approval. In August of 2015 the VT Dept. of Libraries was awarded a federal National Leadership for Libraries grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). This federal grant award of \$339,861 is for introducing science, technology, economics, and math (STEM) methods to young children, their families, and community child care providers. This project serves as a model for a nationwide STEM learning program for children, which can be replicated in small and rural libraries. Major partners in the project are the Vermont Center for the Book, and the Montshire Museum of Science.

In the past few weeks, Finance and Management discovered that the grant acceptance had not followed State policy and procedures, and this grant did not receive required approval from the Joint Fiscal Committee. This oversight was the result of a number of factors, which include staff turnover in the Dept. of Libraries, as well as an unfamiliarity with proper State grant acceptance procedures. Work has already started under this grant. If not approved work will immediately end, and the costs would need to be covered by the General Fund.

Both Finance and Management and the Secretary of Administration office will be working with the Dept. of Libraries staff to ensure this error does not occur in the future.

SUBJECT: Delays in Paying Invoices, VELI-STEM Grant

Description of Grant

In August 2015 the Department of Libraries was awarded a federal National Leadership for Libraries grant award of \$339,861 from the Insitute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) to fund the Vermont Early Literacy Initiative – STEM (VELI-STEM) project in 26 public libraries. The purpose of the grant is to introduce physical science learning and methods of inquiry to young children, their families, and community child care providers. The project is intended to develop a model for STEM learning for young children that can be replicated in small and rural libraries nationwide.

Our major partner in this project is the Vermont Center for the Book; their (2) personnel will training and materials to library staff in the 26 project public libraries. Montshire Museum of Science is also a partner. Contractors included in the grant proposal who have already performed grant work: (a) Karen Worth, author, college professor, and subject expert, (2) Kelly Myles, who will do the evaluation and assessment of the grant project, and (3) Greg DiFrancis, Montshire Museum.

The Grant kick-off was a January press conference with the Governor at the State House. Since then, Kelly Myles has performed a variety of work, including developing the evaluation model/tools and working with individual libraries and with the VT Center for the Book. The Vermont Center for the Book has provided training and materials to the project libraries. Both the Montshire and Karen Worth have acted as subject experts and have participated in training. VTLIB employee Mara Siegel has assisted in the development of an online clearinghouse of STEM resources for use with young children.

Current Challenges:

Grant project personnel got off to a strong start and the quality of work has been consistently high. We have no problem with the grant project itself; librarians are enthusiastic and all activities are on schedule. However, we have had turnover in staff at the Department of Libraries and have fallen behind in required grants management and contracting. This has happened for a number or reasons, notably:

- A. The absence of a grants manager position in LIB or in the AoA business office.
- B. Grants management has been assumed by the Executive Asst. without any particular special knowledge, skill or training.
- C. We lack a Grants Management Plan and had never before used the Bulletin 3.5 procedures.
- D. We did not realize that contracts were required for personnel listed in the grant.
- E. We have seen the loss of two Executive Assts during this time:
 - The first left to work on a political campaign
 - The second left before the end of the probation period

The new (2 weeks) Exec Asst is experienced in contracting and is superb, so we are moving ahead quickly with contracts.

- F. Contracts were delayed significantly while Contractors (e.g. Karen Worth and Kelly Myles) worked with Risk Management to satisfy state insurance requirements.
- G. I have worked repeatedly on completing the A-1 form before finally completing the form accurately. Mostly this was a time problem this task was always put on the "back burner" when doing other work of the Department.
- H. Much of my focus over the past 12 months has been on coping with budget and staff cuts.

Request / Solution:

Contractors/partners have been following our procedures for submitting monthly time reports/invoices for payment.

At first, we were able to process payment with state GF while we worked on grants management paperwork and contracts. These expenditures will be reimbursed by the federal funding agency once we have approval/acceptance of the grant. In the meantime, we hit the a GF threshold in May and unpaid invoices have been piling up.

Kelly Myles (evaluator) has stopped her work (in August) pending back payment and we need her to act this month and in October on required assessment activity. Delay in this work threatens the entire project.

Vermont Center for the Book operates on a narrow margin and relies on grants from multiple sources. They are currently experiencing a cash flow problem due to the fact that we have not paid invoices
