Enclosed please find two (2) items that the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the administration.

JFO #2680 – Donation of 0.03 acres of land (estimated value: \$5,000) from Steve and Jane Glass to the Vermont Department of Fish & Wildlife. Located in Craftsbury, this donation will provide public access to Great Hosmer Pond for fishing, hunting, trapping, wildlife viewing and watercraft launching. State funds in the amount of \$1,750 (special funds) will be used, along with federal funds, to cover closing costs, etc. [*JFO received 04/25/14*]

JFO #2681 – Donation of 10 acres of land (estimated value: \$27,500) from Engineers Construction, Inc. to the Vermont Department of Fish & Wildlife. Located in Wolcott, this donation will provide public access to the Lamoille River for fishing, hunting, trapping, wildlife viewing, and protect riparian, wetland and forested habitat. State funds in the amount of \$250 (special funds) will be used, along with federal funds, to cover closing costs, etc. [*JFO received 04/25/14*]

RE: Governor's Approval recommended and requested for the acceptance of a donation of a parcel located in the Town of Wolcott.

Enclosed is a request for Governor Shumlin's approval and signature for the acceptance of a parcel of land totaling approximately 10 acres from Engineers Construction, Inc. of Williston, VT to the State of Vermont. The addition of this parcel, located in the Town of Wolcott, to the Fish and Wildlife Department's Riparian Lands program will permanently guarantee public access to Lamoille River for fishing, hunting, trapping and wildlife viewing, will conserve 2,300 linear feet and 10 acres of riparian, wetland and forested upland habitat and contribute to flood resiliency. Total costs for this project are approximately \$1,000 for attorney fees and closing costs.

Funding for the associated costs of this donation will come from federal funding to the Fisheries Division. Included with the Governor's approval memo are a map of the property, a copy of the review and approval by the Agency Land Acquisition Review Committee and a copy of a letter signed by the Wolcott Select Board stating town support for the state acquisition of this parcel.

<u>Recommendation</u> Approval of the acceptance of a donation of a parcel totaling approximately 10 acres from Engineers Construction, Inc. of Williston, VT to the Fish and Wildlife Department (FWD) to permanently guarantee public access and habitat protection along the Lamoille River in the Pottersville area of Wolcott, VT.

Description of Project

The Fisheries Division is responsible for management of Riparian Lands, unimproved access points and developed Access Areas along waters throughout Vermont. From the 1950s to the 1970s the Department managed a program that acquired fee interest in extensive segments of riverfront land for angler access and riparian conservation. The most significant concentration of these lands is along the Barton, Black, Willoughby and Lamoille rivers in the Northeast Kingdom, where the Department owns many miles of frontage. The Fisheries Division considers targeted acquisitions of additional riparian lands to be in the interest of protecting fish habitat, fish populations, public access for fish- and wildlife-based activities and contributing to flood resiliency.

The Lamoille River in Wolcott, from the Village of Hardwick's Potterville hydroelectric dam downstream through the village of Wolcott, is noteworthy for its moderate gradient, ledge drops, rapids and riffles that contribute water quality ameliorating re-aeration after impacts of the Hardwick Lake and Pottersville impoundments in the several-mile segment upstream. These above features along with associated large pools offer excellent conditions for trout. As a result the reach supports very good populations of brown trout and rainbow trout, and a popular fishery.

Engineers Construction, Inc. of Williston, VT owns a 10-acre forested parcel situated between the (onetime) St. Johnsbury/Lamoille County railroad bed on the north and the Lamoille River on the south, extending from the Village of Hardwick dam parcel (upstream) nearly to the VT Route 15 bridge (downstream). Early last winter Ken Pidgeon, president of Engineers Construction contacted FWD staff about his interest to donate the property to the FWD for it to be protected and always accessible to the public

APPROVAL FOR PURCHASE OF LAND

We the undersigned, hereby approve the acceptance of a donation of a 10-acre parcel from Engineers Construction, Inc., to the Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Fish and Wildlife to guarantee public access to the Lamoille River in Wolcott, VT.
