Subject: Position and Grant Requests – JFO #2917- #2918

Enclosed please find two (2) items, which the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the administration.

JFO #2917 – One (1) limited-service position within the VT Military Department. The position would be titled Military Property Management Specialist and would be charged with maintaining real property records for the VT Army National Guard (VTARNG). The additional position is being requested due to increasing audit and regulation requirements in recent years and due to the increase in the real property value of VTARNG land and facilities. The position would be funded through 9/30/2019 from 100% federal dollars.

JFO #2918 – \$250,000 from the Great Lakes Fisheries Commission to the VT Dept. of Fish and Wildlife. The grant money would be used to fund an angler survey of Lake Memphremagog aimed at improving the management of the lake as a fishery. \$175,000 of the money would be given as a sub-grant to an organization in Quebec for survey work on the Canadian side of the lake and the remainder would be used for seasonal staff and operating expenses over two years on the Vermont side of the lake.



Enclosed is a Request for Grant Acceptance (Form AA-1) for \$250,000 from the Great Lakes Fisheries Commission that will fund an angler survey on the entirety of Lake Memphremagog (Magog).

In 1988 a joint Quebec Ministry of Natural Resources and Wildlife (MFFP)/Vermont Department of Fish and Wildlife (VTFW) angler survey was conducted on both sides of the international border during the open water angling season. In 1991 and in 2001 VTFW conducted winter and open water angler surveys on portions of Magog. Since 2001, no angler surveys have been conducted on the Vermont portion or the Quebec portion of the lake but multiple tributaries (Clyde River, Willoughby River, Barton River and Black River) have been assessed for angler use. This lack of current data presents a problem for management of the fisheries, particularly when considering the multitude of changes that have occurred since the last joint survey in 1988; introduction of white perch and northern pike, introduction of starry stonewort and other aquatic nuisance species, a general decrease in angling license sales, an increase in other outdoor recreational user groups and new regulations and management objectives to respond to species of concern on the lake.

For all these reasons, whether fish management through regulation or to have a further understanding of angling pressure and angler preference, we propose a collaborative, contemporary angler survey to collect data on the entire lake beginning in the winter of 2018/19 and continuing through the open water season of 2020. The total project cost is \$250,000 of which approximately \$175,000 will be passed through to a non-profit conservation organization for work in Quebecin the form of a subgrant, \$40,000 earmarked for seasonal staff over a two-year period and the balance for operating expenditures related to the project.

The department will measure the success of this project by analyzing and reporting angler effort, angler catch rate, angler harvest, angler opinions of fisheries regulations and angler satisfaction. These data will be used to guide stocking rates and future changes to regulations including; length limits, catch limits and season lengths.
