Grant/Position Request

Enclosed please find four (4) items that the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the administration. Six (6) limited service positions are associated with these items.

JIFO #2669 -Six (6) limited service positions in the Department of Children and Families. These positions will be responsible for cases in the Disability Determination Division, including claims receipt and eligibility decisions. The positions are 100% federally funded (salary and benefits) and funding has already been approved by the legislature.

JFO #2670 - Donation of 212 acres of land (appraised value: \$215,100) from Vermont Electric Power Company (VELCO) to the Vermont Department of Fish & Wildlife. This donation will preserve public access for hunting, fishing, and wildlife viewing. The donation is being made to satisfy a condition of the Public Service Board. Duck Stamp Fund monies (\$3,000) will be used to pay associated legal fees. [JFO received 03/14/14]

JFO #2671 - \$41,600 grant from WomanSafe, Inc. to the Vermont Department of State's Attorneys and Sheriffs. These funds will be used to hire (via contract) a part time Victim Advocate in the Addison County office for advocacy for victims of domestic and sexual violence. [JFO received 03/14/14]

JFO #2672 - \$10,000 grant from the National Alcohol Beverage Control Association to the Vermont Department of Liquor Control. These funds will be used to create and purchase wine bags containing educational messages (such as "Do Not Drink and Drive"). These bags will be distributed to first class establishments and then provided to customers who have purchased a bottle of wine and are taking the remainder of its contents home after their meal. Enclosed is a request by the Department of Liquor Control (DLC) for approval of a one-time grant for Wine Bags to be used in our 1st class Establishments when customers remove a partially consumed bottle at the end of their meal.

The \$10,000 grant is being offered by the National Alcohol Beverage Control Association. There are no new positions associated with it, nor does it add to the base budget of the Department.

The grant would fund collaboration between DLC and licensed wineries for the purchase, creation and printing of the Wine Bags. Each bag would carry an educational message, for example: "Do not drink and drive". Licensed wineries and distributors would dispense the bags to area businesses. This funding would support responsible consumption, and I appreciate your consideration of this request.
